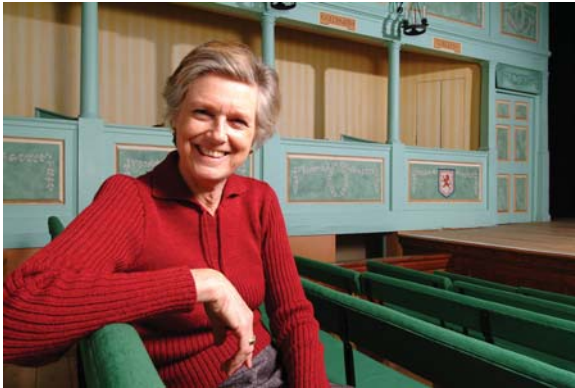




The Sylvia Crathorne Memorial Trust
